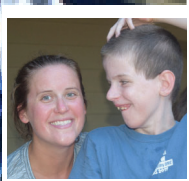

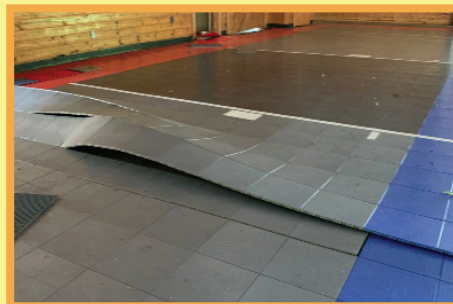
Abbie and Lance, summer staff and Dadeville locals, will be sharing fun adventures!

Storm damage

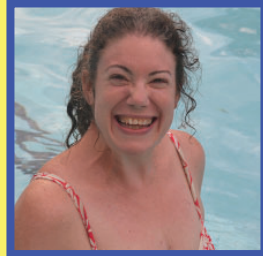
