

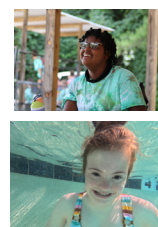

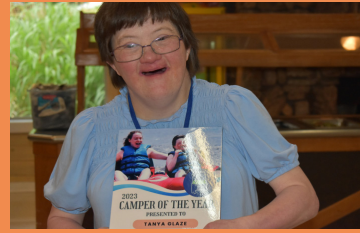
Camper of the Year 2023

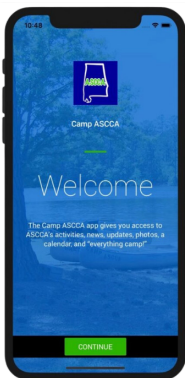
